The next year found the class with new resolutions, attitudes, and a new batch of experiments in Physics, to boot. By this time a closer tie had formed between the classes and the teachers.

The month of February was spent for the last fling on parties before the final exams came. On the eleventh, the Junior-Senior Prom was held at the Bulakeña. A despedida party for Professor Canave was sponsored by the UPHSCA.

March found the class much sobered up. A schedule for the final test was thumb-tacked on the bulletin board — the first harbinger of the coming final exams.

The seniors took their final exams on the 30th and 31st of March. Fortunately, only a few failed to hurdle the exams.

On April 21st, the seniors received their final acknowledgment as graduates from the U. P. high.

They emerged triumphant, not without failures and shortcomings, but they can not be denied the credit of coming out a little bit wiser and with a new sense of humility.

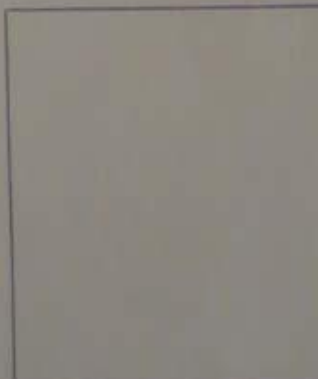

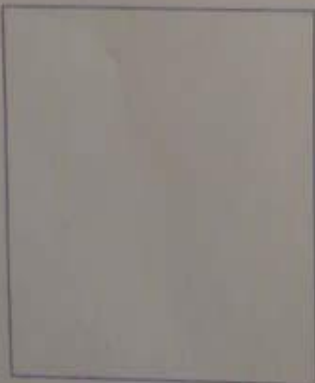

### COMMISH, ALLIES TO SIGN PEACE TREATY

Cowan, Romulo To Represent U. S., Philippines

The City of Manila will be the scene of the next United Nations Conference. This was announced by General Carlos P. Romulo in a cable received by the Department of Foreign Affairs.

The signing of the Peace Treaty between Communist countries and the allies will highlight the important conference and this was made possible thru the mediation of General Carlos P. Romulo. The Peace Treaty was the result of the sudden downfall of Stalin. Manila was selected the site of the conference since General Romulo is from the Philippines.

It was also learned that Foreign diplomats will be arriving next week. They will take the Philippine Navy Flag Ship "Philippines" piloted by Commodore Juan Dixon. They will be met by a delegation headed by the President of the Philippines. Members of the delegation are the Senate President, Speaker of the House, Justices of the Supreme Court, Cabinet Members, Foreign Ambassadors, and Press representatives.

The conference will commence on May 1 and will end at the end of this month. The conference will be covered by tele-station DZUP, it was learned through the manager of the station, Mr. Teodoro Bonifacio. The conference is to be presided by General Romulo. With the signing of the Peace Treaty, "Peace on Earth" will be assured. This may be the greatest victory of all times. (Continued on page 4)

### Two New Inventions Granted Patents By Congress

Mr. Tomas Carunungan, Jr., owner and manager of the famed "El Filipino Printing Press," who invented a new kind of press, got a patent for his work. The peace treaty between Russia and the Western Allies has already been concluded. It will be formally signed by the nations on May 1st.

Will Russia keep her side of the agreement? It has been known that nations respect treaties only when they find them advantageous, but if they proved to be otherwise, these nations will regard the treaties as mere scraps of paper.

At present, sporadic rebellions have been popping out throughout Russia. The common Russian peasant is slowly realizing the nightmare of the supposed ros-colored dream of communism. ### Industrialist To Build Ship Yard

Industrialist Benigno Agbayani is a given release yesterday said that the Philippine Industrialists' Corporation will establish a shipyard at Cebu.

As the president of the board of directors, Mr. Agbayani was given the authority to continue with the project. This was learned at the meeting of the board of directors.

This will be the first privately owned ship-building corporation. The shipyard will be constructed by the firm of Engineers Ricardo Pascual. The yearly output of the shipyard will be three ships.

It was reliably learned that a ship has been ordered by Indonesia through the Consulate in Cebu, headed by Consul General Conrado Valdez.

### Better Food Consumption Reduces Disease Rate

Rosella Ordoñez, Bachelor scholar in Home Economics, stated today that Filipinos are eating the right kind of diet.

This can be shown according to her by the seldom occurrence of disease nowadays. The prevalence of beriberi in mothers and infants are almost reduced to nil. Her statement was confirmed by Dr. Ricardo Cruz and Dr. Benedicto Parker of the Philippine General Hospital. According to them, Miss Ordoñez' observation was accurate and could be considered an official statement.

Ordoñez stated that the present food consumption is better than the preceding years in that the average Filipino diet contains less carbohydrates and more of proteins, vitamins, minerals, etc.

She further declared that we still have room for improvements. One of this is that the Filipino family could eat more sugar in as much as the present sugar production is abundant in supply. She hopes that in the near future we will be on the same level or higher in food consumption per capita as compared to the United States.

### Dr. Regala Discovers Cure For Cancer

Dr. Emilio Regala, Jr. a well-known physician who specialized in cancer abroad, found a drug which cures this disease. This is an important discovery in medicine and the science of pathology.

Dr. Regala was sent to Johns Hopkins Hospital both as a pensioner and a scholar where he found the cure for cancer through a painstaking study on this drug. The discovery came about when he noticed a sudden chemical reaction in the infected part of a patient. He took the sample and analyzed it under the compound microscope. He found out that the reaction is produced by certain kinds of antibodies in the blood which he named "Regalocytes." On further analysis, he discovered a certain kind of bacteria which causes cancer. This bacteria gains entrance in the human body through any opening and thrives best in joints. After learning these facts, he set out to find the cure.

He found the herb whose constituents locate the blood to produce more regalocytes and counter-act the germs. He named the herb in honor of his friends "Virgilio Morterium." This herb is abundant in tropical countries like the Philippines.

### "Round-The-World" Squadron Arrived Yesterday

The "round-the-world" squadron arrived yesterday after completing their tour. This was the first tour of its kind.

Major Tommy Curragan of the PAF, flight commander of the squadron, revealed that "this is just the beginning." Members of the Squadron were Capt. Rodolfo Ramos, holder of several world records for endurance flights, First Lt. Rodolfo Bagatin, Lt. Justino Tizon, 2nd Lt. Rogelio Retuya, Capt. Enrique Andara, and Lt. Cesar Baris.

Among the places visited by the squadron were Indo-China, India, Africa, Arabia, France, England, Greenland, Alaska, United States, Japan and then back to the Philippines. It was a non-stop flight testing the ability of the aviators in different climatic conditions. This tour was completed without any accident.

General Cruz of the PAF commended the work done by the squadron and stated that he was very pleased at the results of the tour.

Well-known engineers, alumni members of the Tau Alpha Fraternity of the UP College of Engineering are pooling their resources over the projected plan of the 30-story capitol building to be built at Navaliches. Professor Alejandro Mislat, architect-founder of the Mislat Institute of Technicians, is the designing architect of the group headed by Mr. Marcelo David Santos, leading constructing and consulting engineer of the country.

The other members of the group are Engineers Agaton Basald, Elpidio Lalang, Pedro Ramos and Juan Sanchez, each of them a credit to the profession and to their Alma Mater. These enterprising young men have pursued post graduate studies abroad.

Don Delfin Collins, owner and president of the COCONCORP (Collina Construction Corporation) won the bid for the construction materials for the project which is estimated at 80 million pesos.

The elevator equipment, refrigeration, automatic electric fixtures, pneumatic equipment of the building are under the supervision of Mr. Arturo Lam, a mechanical engineering graduate of UP, who mastered hydraulics and pneumatics in Cornell University.

Congress passed the bill appropriating the amount for the project and after the Presidential nod, the go-signal for the work will start right away.

**Medical Men Support Campos Proposal**

At the meeting of some prominent medical men of the country, it was affirmed that members of the medical profession will wholeheartedly support the bill proposed by Congressman Campos of the House of Representatives.

This bill calls for the establishment of a research center in Mindanao. This was hailed by the medical profession as it will minimize the death rate of tuberculosis in Mindanao.

The leader of the group, Dr. Vicente Saperiada, will appear before Congress to express the opinion of the medical profession. This was said at the convention of agronomists held yesterday. Among the things accomplished was the awarding of a "Farmer Award" to Mr. Jose Cuajunco, Mr. Cuajunco is a noted agriculturist and he will be remembered for his famous researches on soil erosion. He was able to find out the method needed to minimize soil washing especially in the plains of the Ilocos Region and Cagayan Valley.

A special award was also given to Mr. Victor Peres, an agriculturist from Cagayan. He was responsible for controlling the pests that attack the aromatic tobacco. With the control of the pest, a tremendous production of aromatic tobacco was made possible.

Mr. Mortera, in his speech, remarked that "mechanization is responsible for the large food and export crop production this year." He praised the local farmers for their well-done task which contributed to world peace.

Mr. Mortera closed his speech by thanking the government for aiding the rehabilitation of agriculture here in the Philippines.

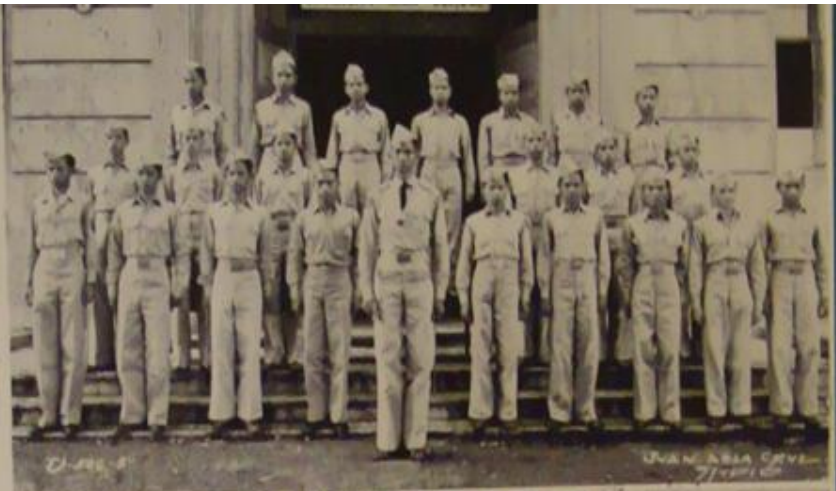

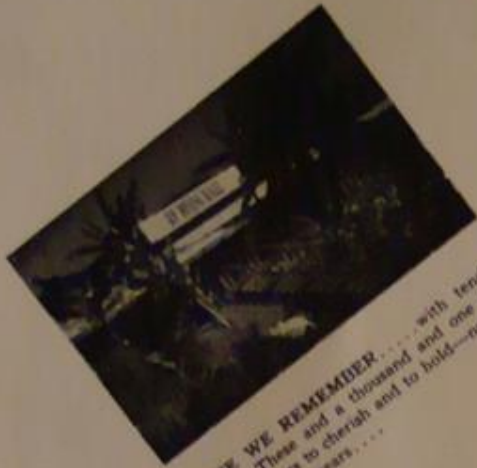
